Aligning with who God says I am

Remember ye not the former things, neither consider the things of old. Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it? I will even make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert. Isa 43:18-21

1. Point one: Remember Not.

I think God is shaking the mindset of his Church. During lockdown people are thinking what the "new norm" what will look like.

What if the new normal isn't something to get back to? What if normal is something to look forward to? what if normal we knew is not the normal God is leading us into next? God said "I'm bringing you into a new normal, because what you thought was normal wasn't really normal. it was just what you knew." Steve Furtick

- What if we sought God for how the new would look like? the new normal??
- What if the new normal was more like the Book of Acts, the early Church? Signs and wonders was seen as normal in the early Church.

Only now - Christians are truly comprehending the Church isn't a building with routine and programmes.

I sense the Church is shifting mindsets, almost a new Reformation (of thinking, dispensation), a new Renaissance (rebirth) Both were born out of a time of darkness but changed the world for the better.
